**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an institution of higher learning as deemed to be University.

2. And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, vide Notification No.9-19/2000-U.3 dated 13.04.2006, on the advice of UGC, had declared KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum, Karnataka, comprising (i) Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Belgaum and (ii) KLE BK Institute of Dental Sciences, Belgaum, as an institution deemed to be University, for a period of five years.

3. And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, following institutions were brought under ambit of KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research, Belgaum, by the Central Government vide Notification No.9-19/2000-U.3 dated 20.02.2009 subject to the conditions that all the terms & conditions of conferment of deemed to be university status to KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum shall remain unchanged:

- i. KLE Institute of Nursing Sciences, Belgaum;
- ii. KLE Institute of Physiotherapy, Belgaum;
- iii. KLE Shri B.M.K. Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Belgaum;
- iv. KLE College of Pharmacy, Belgaum;
- v. KLE College of Pharmacy, Hubli;
- vi. KLE College of Pharmacy, Bangalore.

4. And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, vide Notification No.9-19/2000-U3(A)Pt.1 dated 17.01.2017, on the advice of UGC, extended the status of deemed to be university to KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum from 13.04.2011 to 12.04.2016. Further, the Central Government, vide Notification No. 9-19/2000-U3(A)Pt.1 dated 02.07.2018, on the advice of UGC, extended the status of deemed to be university to KLE

Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum from 13.04.2016 to 12.04.2019 with the following conditions:

- i. The institution shall create a separate & exclusive not-for-profit Society / Trust / Company for managing the deemed to be university.
- ii. The Institution shall submit compliance report w.r.t. suggestions / deficiencies pointed out by the UGC Expert Committee.

5. Now, therefore, taking into consideration the compliance report of the Institution and the advice of UGC, the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, hereby extends the deemed to be University status of KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum, Karnataka from 13.04.2019 to 18.01.2021 with the following condition:

- i. The Institution deemed to be University shall improve its ranking / grading in National Institutional Rankings Framework (NIRF) / National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
- ii. The Institution shall improve its performance and academic outcomes on the parameters mentioned in the UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2019.

6. The all other conditions mentioned in the earlier Notification(s) of this Ministry as well as the Rules / Regulations of UGC and other Statutory Councils, issued from time to time, shall continue to be adhered by KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Belgaum, Karnataka.

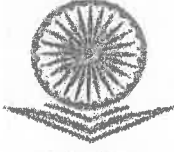

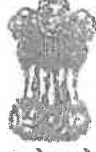

**Subject:-** Categorization of the Deemed to be University under UGC [Categorization of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy] Regulations, 2018.

Sir,

As you are aware, UGC is mandated to determine, promote and maintain the standards of higher education in the country. UGC is constantly striving to create an enabling environment whereby higher educational institutions in the country can become institution of global excellence. UGC is also aware that global excellence can be achieved by extending autonomy to better performing institutions for promoting and institutionalizing excellence in higher education.

In order to grant autonomy to the better performing institutions, UGC has notified UGC [Categorization of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy] Regulations, 2018 on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 in the Gazette of India.

The proposal received from K.L.E. Academy of Higher Education and Research under the above UGC Regulations has been examined, processed and considered by the Commission in its 532<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 24.05.2018. The Commission has decided to grade the K.L.E. Academy of Higher Education and Research as Category-II Deemed to be University as per the provisions of the above UGC Regulations. The Deemed to be University shall now be eligible for all the benefits as stipulated under Clause 5 (Dimensions of Autonomy for Category-II Universities) of the above mentioned UGC Regulations. However, with respect to Clause 5.2 of the Regulations (pertaining to opening of off-campus centers), the Commission is in a process of finalizing certain modalities related to its implementation. The same will be communicated separately.

The Deemed to be University shall inform the UGC about the benefits being implemented from the new academic session. In light of this, the Deemed to be University should acknowledge in writing that it shall strictly comply with all the regulations as mentioned in the provisions (Clause 5) of the University Grants Commission (Categorization of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy) Regulations, 2018.

It is further informed that the Deemed to be University shall intimate the Commission about its changed status as per Clause 6 of the said regulations.

**NOTIFICATION**


In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the University Grants Commission, hereby declares the K.L.E. Academy of Higher Education and Research, Belgum (Karnataka) consisting of (i) K.L.E. Society's Jawaharal Nehru Medical College, Belgum and (ii) K.L.E. Society's Institute of Dental Sciences, Belgum as Deemed to be University for the purpose of the aforesaid Act provisionally for a period of five years from the date. K.L.E. Academy of Higher Education and Research stands disaffiliated from the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. This is subject to review by a Review Committee to be appointed by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Government of India or the University Grants Commission will not provide any Plan or Non Plan grants to the Academy.
